TBIB Insurance Broker Steve Weil attended the meeting to update the Management Committee on its insurance offerings to the Bridge Community. The ABF will renew the Voluntary Workers policy in August at a \$1,500 saving on last year with no decrease in cover. This covers volunteers working for the ABF, State and Territory Associations, as well as affiliated clubs. Steve also spoke about future sponsorship of the ABF.
