f) Professional Indemnity Insurance

Onerous task of collection of data. Treasurer to gather data on all ABF Events, Directors and Volunteer Insurance.

g) Conveners for ABF & Licensed events
Renewal option for ABF and Licenses events.
Directors to sign? General Counsel to be consulted.

h) AOB

ACT - Friday afternoon for Youth bridge is very successful. Gold point event for ACT. BFACT to have own website.

SABF – Recently received invoices for web site usage. Management Committee to look into costs. Should events be charged to the States when in the interests of the ABF? Change the objectives on the initial link on ABF Website.

TAS – Generic email addresses. License agreements, PQP's clause. Draw for ANC teams. Management Committee will do draw at an appropriate time.

NT – Lack of communications, e.g. Barrier Reef. License agreements should contain a clause that all brochures are sent to all State bodies. Make sure links on web site are correct. Councillors should be getting a copy of the ABF Newsletter. Check with Newsletter Editors on distribution lists. All newsletters are on ABF website.

QLD – Surfers and Barrier Reef excellent. Hard to get volunteer official positions.

VIC – President suffering ill health. Well wishes for a speedy recovery. New manager Cathy Lachman. Numbers are growing. Still permit regulation problems. Some clubs threatened with dis-affiliation.
