The top eight teams from the Qualifying Stage will qualify.

December 5: Quarter-Finals - 2 x 12 board stanzas

Semi-Finals - 2 x 12 board stanzas

December 6: Final - 4 x 12 board stanzas

Session times same as in the Qualifying Stage

December 5: 6 rounds of 8 board matches, commencing at 12 noon AEDT

All players who entered the event but failed to qualify are invited to play.

New entrants and substitutes will not be permitted.
