NORTHERN beaches bridge clubs will go head-to-head against north shore teams in the inaugural Margaret Smale Inter-Club Teams Challenge on the weekend.

About 30 teams including Long Reef, Manly Leagues, Forestville, Mosman, Dee Why and Narrabeen, will compete in

the new competition. Peninsula Bridge Club bridge educator Cath Whiddon told the *Manly Daily* the event was unusual as it focused on team play.

"The idea behind this event is to promote the game of bridge by (people) playing other clubs instead of just in their own club," Ms Whiddon said.

The new event on Sunday follows five years of successful NewsLocal Sydney North Inter-Club Pairs competitions.

The competition was named after Margaret Smale, who loved to play bridge in a range of clubs on the north shore and the peninsula.

Peninsula Bridge Club presi-

dent Alan Davies said that play was broken down into four categories, which made the tournament suitable for people at all skill levels from amateur to grand master.

There will be winners in each category and a perpetual trophy for the most successful bridge club overall.
